

Summarize the considerations before embarking on BD/DNC determination
Patient must have suffered a brain injury
Neurologic diagnosis must be established
This diagnosis must be capable of causing this
Neuroimaging evidence must demonstrate intracranial hypertension or severe cerebral edema and herniation, OR ICP measurements must equal or exceed MAP*
Core temperature must be
MAP ≥ and SBP ≥ must be maintained
Metabolic and toxic derangements must be excluded, corrected, or eliminated
